
Effective monitoring of Revenue Court Cases.

Sir,

With reference to the subject cited above it is informed that monthly information with respect to the disposal of revenue court cases is not being received in this office on regular basis, due to which there is considerable delay in compiling the data and sending the same to the government. Furthermore, the information regarding status of pending cases being sent to this office is based on arbitrary figures resulting in ambiguous information. In this context, SDM Rampur and Rohru were specifically directed during the previous revenue officers meeting held on 28-10-2012, to review the statements being supplied by the respective Tehsildars/ NTs. Though the compliance report from SDM (Rohru) has been received but same is still awaited from SDM Rampur till date. Further, the Revenue Court Monitoring System (RCMS) has been introduced by the State Government wherein revenue court cases have been made online, but the same has not been implemented by the Revenue officers of Distt Shimla till date.

It is therefore, emphasized that the revenue court cases may be made online through RCMS software immediately, so that there is no need for physically communicating the progress report to the Distt. Headquarter through Dak. Secondly, the progress of court cases may be reviewed/ monitored by the concerned SDO(C)s by conducting revenue officers meeting at Sub Division level on monthly basis. All the SDO(C)s are therefore directed to implement RCMS software in true spirit and manner so as to avoid delay and maintain accuracy in figures. The compliance report be sent to this office at the earliest.
