

Proceeding of the meeting held on 20-09-2016 with Joint Patwar & Kanungo Association of District Shimla under the Chairmanship of Deputy Commissioner, Shimla in his office room at 03:00 PM.

At the very outset Shri Suneel Sharma, Addl. District Magistrate (P), Shimla welcomed the worthy Deputy Commissioner, Shimla and delegates of Joint Patwar & Kanungo Association, District Shimla. Thereafter, with the permission of Chair, the agenda items were taken up for discussion. The discussion held as under:

Demand No. 1- Reg. Writing of ACRs of Kanungos / Patwaris in time:

It was pointed out by the delegates of the Association that the ACRs were not being written in time; resultantly there were occurring delays in granting due service benefits. The demand of the Association was held genuine. The Chair directed to write a letter from his behalf to all the Reporting Officers (Tehsildars / Naib Tehsildars) directing them to make it sure that the ACRs are written well in time and are necessarily sent to SDMs (Reviewing Officers) concerned before 31st of May every year. The SDMs be asked to make all such ACRs available to him on or before 30th of June every year so that the ACR dossiers of the officials concerned may remain updated.

Demand No. 2- Reg TA / Medical Bills:

The delegates of the Association apprised that their TA / Medical bills were in pendency for want of budget. In this context, it was briefed to the Association that the budget has already been allocated to all the DDOs accordingly. There was demand for additional budget only from the office of Sub Divisional Officer (Civil), Theog. The Chair desired to take up the matter with the office of Director Land records, H.P. for the release of additional funds.

Demand No. 3-Reg. Providing of Furniture to Kanungo / Patwar Bhavans:

The matter was discussed. It was decided that two Chairs, one table and one Almirah will be provided to each Kanungo / Patwar Bhavan in a phase manner. It was desired to ask all the Tehsildars / Naib Tehsildars to work out the requirement of each Patwar Circles and submit the proposals accordingly to District headquarter for taking action.

Demand No. 4 -Reg. Monthly salary of Contractual Employees:

The Association was demanding to allow the salary to contractual Patwaris on the basis of revised pay scale i.e minimum of the revised pay band + Grade pay (10300 + 3200). It was informed to Association that the instant matter was in the competency of Government and hence, it was desired to refer the case to Government through the office of Director Land Records, H.P. for favourable action.

Demand No. 5-Reg. Payment of Electricity Bills from Govt. Exchequer:

The Association was demanding to pay the electricity bills from Government exchequer in toto as the amount of Rs. 50/- being paid was negligible. The Chairman desired to take up the matter with the office of DLR and recommend that the amount being paid presently be enhanced from Rs. 50/- to Rs. 300/- P.M.

Demand No. 6-Reg. appointment of FKs in all the Sub Tehsils:

The Association was apprised that the appointment / posting of Field Kanungos had already been made in each Sub Tehsil. However, it was desired to appoint one F.K. at Nankhari against newly created F.K. Circle.

Demand No.7-Reg. appointment of new Patwaris in Patwar Circles :

This was held genuine. It was revealed that all the new appointments were made against vacancies in field. It was stressed to ensure that the all new postings are made in field in future too.

Demand No. 8-Reg. allotment of Budget for the construction of newly created Patwar Circles:

The matter was discussed that requirement of budget has been sought for from all concerned, but the proposals were still awaited. It was desired to expedite the matter.

Demand No. 9-Reg. appointment of Chowkidars in Kanugno / Patwar Circles:

It was apprised to Association that all the SDMs have already been directed to make the appointment ^{of} Revenue Chowkidars in all such Patwar Kahanas where no revenue Chowkidar is posted on priority.

In the end, it was also desired by the Chair that the meeting with the Association be conducted quarterly on regular basis and then the meeting ended with a vote of thanks to and from the Chair.
